



## Mea Orn, Karen Hilltribe Village, Chiang Dow

On evening of 23rd we traveled from the Akha village to the Karen Hilltribe village where we joined them for Christmas Carol service on the evening of the 23rd December 2006. On 24th, December 2006 we brought Christmas to the poor and needy in Chiang Dow, Chiang Mai to over 500 Karen Hilltribe people. Majority are already Christian's and serve the Lord Jesus faithfully, but many almost 99% do not understand the true meaning of His grace many believe that they are saved by baptism. This church and the people attending need to grow in many areas. The new Pastor is a full on born again Christian and is slowly trying to change the churches old fashioned American Southern Baptist way of thinking to a more realistic spirit filled grace filled church. He is trying to grow his new flock slowly by the Grace of God. Many of these Christian's have received a major boost in their faith and understood many new things from the preaching and the full on worship service that we with DCI and Jesus preparing the way.

We did Christmas Caroling with the village and again like all Karen Hilltribes people they really know how to professionally Christmas Carol, we went to every house in the valley and spent a good 7 hours doing this mountainous trek from house to house, having split up into two large groups. We sang at least three carols at each house and prayed for them. The message of the gospel was brought to the entire valley thousands that evening and the next day I was blessed and used to preach and brought Christmas to over 500 Karen Hilltribes peoples from within the church service. We brought gifts for all of the children and made a small blessing to the church "Thank you **DCI**"
